A69 Haltwhistle Bypass

PROJECT

The A69 Carlisle - Newcastle was the first contract in the £1billion Design, Build, Finance and Operate (DBFO) programme. The contract was awarded to Road Link (A69) Ltd a consortium of six companies comprising Morrison Construction, Christiani & Nielsen Ltd, Henry Boot Construction, Impregilo S.p.A, ASTM SINA and Pell Frischmann.

The Bypass (built to relieve traffic using the A69 through Haltwhistle and reduce accident, congestion, air pollution, noise and vibration) is approximately 3.5 kilometres long and required the construction of 3 major structures; 2 bridge crossings of the river South Tyne and a bridge crossing the Newcastle to Carlisle Railway. The bypass is a single carriageway with metre wide strips over the whole length.
