Centre Park – Warrington, Cheshire

PROJECT

Centre Park was constructed on the site of former paper mill adjacent to the River Mersey close to Warrington Town Centre. To develop the site extensive remediation was required, together with design and construction of a 30m span through truss steel bridge, a network of adoptable roads and sewers and extensive landscaping.

Centre Park is now a very successful town centre office park, which has seen each speculative phase of development fully let, with further development planned. Detached office buildings of 5-10,000 sq ft are arranged around a quality landscaped environment, and complemented by facilities provided by a Village Hotel & Leisure Club, Travel Inn and Beefeater public house.
